The purpose of this privacy policy

The purpose of this privacy policy is to inform users of our site of the personal data that we will collect as well as the following information, if applicable:

- b. Use of data collected

Applicable Laws

In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), this privacy policy complies with the following regulations.

Personal data must be:

- a. Processed lawfully, fairly and transparently with regard to the data subject (lawfulness, loyalty, transparency);
- b. Collected for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes, and not to be further processed in a manner incompatible with these purposes; further processing for archival purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research purposes or for statistical purposes is not considered, in accordance with Article 89 (1), to be incompatible with the original purposes (limitation purposes);
- vs. Adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary with regard to the purposes for which they are processed (data minimization);
- d. Accurate and, if necessary, kept up to date; all reasonable measures must be taken to ensure that personal data which are inaccurate, having regard to the purposes for which they are processed, are erased or rectified without delay (accuracy);
- e. Kept in a form allowing the identification of the persons concerned for a period not exceeding that necessary for the purposes for which they are processed; personal data may be kept for longer periods as long as they will be processed exclusively for archival purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research purposes or for statistical purposes in accordance with Article 89, paragraph 1, provided that the appropriate technical and organizational measures required by the Regulation are implemented in order to guarantee the rights and freedoms of the data subject (limitation of retention);
- f. Processed in such a way as to ensure appropriate security of personal data, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, using appropriate technical or organizational measures (integrity and confidentiality).

Processing is only lawful if, and insofar as, at least one of the following conditions is met:

a. The data subject has consented to the processing of their personal data for one or more specific purposes;

- b. Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject;

- e. Processing is necessary for the performance of a public interest task or relating to the exercise of public authority vested in the controller;

User rights

In accordance with the regulations concerning the processing of personal data, the user has the rights listed below.

In order for the person in charge of data processing to grant his request, the user is required to provide him with his first and last names as well as his e-mail address.

The person in charge of data processing is required to respond to the user within a maximum period of 30 days.

Presentation of the user's rights in terms of data collection and processing

1. Right of access, restriction and right to erasure

The user can read, update, modify or request the deletion of data concerning him, respecting the following procedure:

Ø The user must send an email to the person in charge of processing personal data, specifying the subject of his request and using the contact email address provided above.

2. Right to limit and oppose data processing

The user has the right to request the limitation or to oppose the processing of his data by the site, without the site being able to refuse, except to demonstrate the existence of legitimate and compelling reasons, which may prevail over the interests and rights and freedoms of the user.

To request the limitation of the processing of their data or to formulate an opposition to the processing of their data, the user must follow the following procedure:

Ø The user must make a request to limit the processing of his personal data to the data controller by sending an email to the address provided above.

3. Right to determine the sport of data after death

The user is reminded that he can organize what should be the fate of his data collected and processed if he dies, in accordance with Law No. 2016-1321 of October 7, 2016.

4. Right to appeal to the competent supervisory authority

If the data controller decides not to respond to the user's request, and the user wishes to challenge this decision, or, if he thinks that one of the rights listed above has been infringed, he is entitled to appeal to the CNIL (National Commission for Informatics and Freedoms, https://www.cnil.fr) or any competent judge.

We point out that by browsing the site, the user certifies having read and understood this confidentiality policy and accepts its conditions, more particularly regarding to the collection and processing of their personal data.
